We do dentals on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. The patient is dropped off between 7:30-8am and can be picked up between 3-5pm later that day. The basic price of a dental is \$145.00 for a cat and \$210.00 for a dog.

What happens during a dental?

The ultrasonic scaler and tools

1. Bloodwork to check the liver and kidney function
2. Once the patient is under anesthesia, there are always two people in the room with the patient: one doing the procedure and the other monitoring with a pulse-ox, EKG, blood pressure cuff, and thermometer
3. Oral exam, measure the pockets around every tooth, determine if any need to be pulled
4. Scale off the large pieces of tartar
5. Clean all surfaces of the teeth with an ultrasonic scaler
6. Rinse and do any touch up cleaning as needed
7. Polish all surfaces of the teeth
8. While the patient is still under anesthesia, we do a courtesy nail trim, ear cleaning, and anal gland expression
9. We continue to monitor the patient until they are fully awake and then call the owner with short summary of the procedure.
